

Combined Provisional List - BDS Private Foreign Seats Over and Above
Centralized Admission in MBBS/BDS Private Sector Medical/Dental Colleges of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa session 2025-26

1. This list is purely provisional and is based on the data provided by candidates as submitted.
2. Further merit lists will be published after the resolution of complaints received from candidates, and a schedule for the entire admission process and related activities will be made available soon.
3. Inclusion in this provisional merit list does not guarantee admission. If a candidate is found ineligible at any stage due to errors, mistakes, fraud, or misrepresentation, their admission will be revoked. According to Clause 12 of the Admission Policy: "All admissions are provisional. All certificates and documents submitted with the application will be verified. If any document is found incorrect, false, or forged, or if authentication is doubtful, rendering the candidate ineligible under the rules, their name will be removed from the college roll, and legal action may be taken under criminal and civil law."
4. Candidates may file complaints online at <https://caspr.kmu.edu.pk/complaint.php> regarding any errors, omissions, lapses, mistakes, fraud, or misrepresentation in this list by Friday, 16th January 2026, before 12:00 noon. Complaints can only be submitted using the candidate's registered CNIC number (entered during account creation on the online portal) and must include documentary proof (e.g., result card) to support the claim. Complaints without valid proof will be rejected. Hard copy complaints will not be accepted, and there is no need to visit the university for this purpose.
5. To upload any deficient document, candidates must log in to <https://caspr.kmu.edu.pk> using their CNIC number and password.
6. No complaints or applications will be accepted after 12:00 noon on 16th January 2026.
7. As per Section 3 of PM&DC regulations 2025 and KMU Admission Policy 2025-26, candidates with less than 60% marks in HSSC/equivalent or less than 55% in MDCAT 2023, 2024, & 2025 are ineligible for admission to MBBS. Similarly, candidates with less than 50% marks in MDCAT 2023, 2024, & 2025 are ineligible for admission to BDS.
8. As per PM&DC Act 2023 Section 17(4) "**The MDCAT result of one province shall be valid for the entire country and shall be valid for a period of three years. Each province, Gilgit-Baltistan, and Islamabad Capital Territory shall give preference to the students having domicile of their respective province or territory as the case may be.**"
9. Admission under this category shall be governed by the PM&DC Medical and Dental Undergraduate Education (Admissions, Curriculum, and Conduct) Regulations 2025, Chapter 2, Section 7(f). Final adjustment of fees shall be made by the concerned college.
10. Mere figuring in this order of merit shall not confer any right of admission on the candidate if he/she is otherwise found ineligible on detection of any error/mistake/fraud/misrepresentation at any stage of admissions.
